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Dr. David Ross is a Consultant Hematologist in SA Pathology with clinical appointments at the Royal Adelaide Hospital and Flinders Medical Centre in Adelaide, Australia. He completed specialist training in clinical and laboratory hematology at the Royal Adelaide Hospital and the Institute of Medical & Veterinary Science (now SA Pathology). His PhD was on the topic of minimal residual disease and treatment-free remission (TFR) in CML.

He has been an investigator in numerous clinical trials, and was Principal Investigator in the CML8/TWISTER study of TFR after imatinib. He is a member of the Steering Committee for the ENESTfreedom trial of TFR after nilotinib. He supervises the diagnostic haematology service in SA Pathology and is an examiner for the Royal College of Pathologists of Australasia.
